Pupil Deprivation Grant (PDG) and Early Years Pupil Deprivation Grant 2023 - 2024

The PDG and EYPDG are allocated for pupils of low income families who are currently known to be eligible for free school meals and pupils who have been continually looked after for more than 6 months (LAC). The purpose of the grant is to break the link between disadvantage and educational attainment. In our plan we have:

- provide intervention and support programmes proven to have the greatest impact and to be sustainable e.g. Toe by Toe and Springboard Maths
- Implement specific time for tracking interventions and monitoring impact.

Accelerated Learning Grant 2023 - 2024

A grant to support learners whose progress and learning was most affected by covid. We are using this to

- support pupils in the mornings to enable a better staff to pupils' ratio.

Education Improvement Grant 2023 - 2024

A grant to support learners progress and learning. We are using this to:

- support pupils where the greatest need lies

ALN Implementation Grant 2023 - 2024

A grant to support Additional Learning Needs and the ALNCo to ensure the efficiency of this aspect. We are using this to:

- manage ALN

- time to monitor interventions
- resources as required

Professional Learning Grant 2023 - 2024

For the professional development of staff:
